THE HINSDALE ASSEMBLY ANNOUNCES
CLASS OF 2025 GIFT TO HINSDALE HOSPITAL
*2026 Class of Debutantes and Honor Guards Begins Service Year with
New Cardio-Focused Fundraising Pledge*

HINSDALE, IL, February 22, 2026 – The Hinsdale Assembly, the nonprofit fundraising organization of the Hinsdale Hospital Foundation, announced that the 2025 class of Debutantes and Honor Guards raised \$146,000 toward the renovation of the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at UChicago Medicine AdventHealth Hinsdale Hospital at the nonprofit’s annual luncheon on February 22.

This brings the Assembly’s total fundraising amount dedicated to the now completed NICU to more than \$530,000, more than doubling the Assembly’s initial pledge of \$250,000 over five years. The Hinsdale Assembly has now raised nearly \$4M in total since the nonprofit’s inception in 1963.

As the NICU fundraising campaign is now complete, the Hinsdale Assembly has announced that the 2026 Class of Debutants and Honor Guards will begin a one-year fundraising campaign to provide for a 3D-capable Echo Unit, which will capture a patient’s heart structure and function in real-time. In 2020, DuPage County ranked second in the state with the highest number of heart disease deaths, only behind Cook County.

“The Assembly’s investment in a new 3D echocardiography unit enhances the depth of services within our comprehensive cardiovascular program,” said Elise MacCarroll-Wright, President and CEO of UChicago Medicine AdventHealth Hinsdale. “By increasing capacity for advanced cardiac imaging, this addition will support greater efficiency, reduce wait times, and further elevate the diagnostic excellence our teams deliver every day.”

To that end, the Hinsdale Assembly is delighted to name the 2026 Class of Debutantes and Honor Guards. These young women and men are well underway in their philanthropic efforts, through participating in a number of community service projects at organizations including The Wellness House, Bethlehem Woods Retirement Community, HCS Family Services, and more. Their year of service will culminate with the 63rd Hinsdale Assembly Ball on Wednesday, December 23, 2026 at the Hilton Oak Brook Hills Resort.
